### **Ballyclare Comrades Reserves 3-0 Moyola Park Olympic**

A win against Moyola Park Reserves lifted Ballyclare Comrades Reserves towards a mid-table position in the Championship Development League.

Two up at the break at Dixon Park, Stephen Black's lads added another in the second session to secure a deserved 3-0 win.

Jonny Patterson was first on to the scorecard in the 10<sup>th</sup> minute, when he finished off a move involving Ryan Weatherhead, Nathan Sloss and Thomas McKitterick

Midway through the first half Moyola were reduced to ten men when one of their players picked up his second yellow card for fouling Kurt Cooper, so the Wee Reds continued to dominate, and in the 39<sup>th</sup> minute Lukasz Adamczyk doubled the lead, when he tapped in to the net from close range, after Sloss had done the spade-work. Just before the turnaround Sloss, who posed a constant threat down the left flank, rattled the bar with a volley from well outside the box.

Numerous scoring chances were created in the second half, but weak finishing failed to add to the total until Sloss fired into the bottom corner from a pin-point Cooper cross.
