The second half started with a two-goal blast from Scott Cummings. Inside the first minute he robbed a defender and advanced to calmly finish from 7 yards. Then, in the 51<sup>st</sup> minute, the energetic young striker charged down a clearance from the 'keeper and followed in to turn the ball into the empty net from close range.

The scoring was completed in the 78<sup>th</sup> minute, when, after a scramble in the box, Denver Taggart fired the ball high into the net from 12 yards.

Kyle Dillon was unlucky not to add to the score in the 82<sup>nd</sup> minute. He was provided with the chance by a great ball from Kyle Robinson, but his resulting effort from 9 yards came back off the post.
