All four goals were the result of errors, and that was the pattern all afternoon, with far too many passing errors and missed tackles. To be honest we didn’t manage to create a clear-cut scoring chance throughout the ninety minutes. The best we could muster was a couple of half chances that fell to Jack Walshe and Thomas Campbell, but neither troubled their keeper who had an easy afternoon.
